



Climate Summit Registration Terms and Conditions

Registration Fee: Your \$100 registration fee includes admission to the Climate Summit (October 17, 2019) event only. Educators who attend the full event on Thursday, October 17, 2019 will receive a refund of the reservation fee within 10 business days of completing a pre-survey and post-survey at the end of the summit. **You must be an educator in order to receive a refund.** In this context, an educator is defined as an individual who is employed by a public school or local education agency, charter school or management organization, university or college, private school, homeschool educator, preservice or intern teacher, or an educator in an informal science education setting. The offer of a refund for participation does not apply to children, guests, or non-educators.

Cancellation of Registration: If you need to cancel your registration, the cancellation notice must be made in writing and received by California Science Teachers Association (CSTA) prior to September 17, 2019. Cancellations are subject to a \$25 administrative fee.

Refunds: A full refund of the registration fee, less a \$25 administrative fee, will be granted for all written cancellation requests received by September 17, 2019. No refunds will be made for cancellations received after this date. Refunds will be issued based on the manner of payment. There are no refunds for no-shows.

Transfer of Registration Policy: Your event registration is transferable. If you are unable to attend the event for any reason, you may send a colleague to attend in your place. Written permission from the original registrant must be submitted stating to whom you wish to transfer your registration.
